# **Amendments to the Winkler EMM Church's 2022 Constitution**

### **Current wording of Article VIII A. 1. in the Constitution:**

## A. Church Council

1. Church Council shall consist of nine (9) members. The Leader Pastor and Treasurer are appointed to Church Council; the remaining seven (7) are elected from the membership. All members of Church Council have voting privileges. The chair, vice-chair, and secretary are one of the elected members of Church Council.

# **Draft of Proposed Amendment to Church Council A.1. in the Constitution:**

1. "Church Council shall consist of ten (10) members. The <u>Lead</u> Pastor and Treasurer are appointed to Church Council; the remaining <u>eight (8)</u> are elected from the membership. . . ."

# **Current wording of Article VIII A. 12 in the Constitution:**

12. An employee or his/her spouse may not be a member of Church Council, with the exception of the Lead Pastor and the Treasurer who sit on Church Council.

# **Draft of Proposed Amendment to Article VIII A. 12:**

- 12. a) An employee may not be a member of Church Council, with the exception of the Lead Pastor and the Treasurer who sit on Church Council.
  - b) A spouse of a staff member may not serve on Church Council.

### L. Deacon Committee

## 1. Organization

The Deacon Committee shall consist of a minimum of six (6) positions. The Deacon Committee reports to the Congregational Care Pastor. Male or female, single or married couples are welcome to be deacons/deaconesses. A couple will be considered as one position.

# 2. **Duties**

The Deacon Committee shall:

- a) assist in meeting the practical needs of church members;
- b) organize the visitation program.
